Warm Greetings from NPTI/HLTC, Bangalore. We are glad to inform that the "22<sup>nd</sup> Five weeks Training Programme on Live Line Maintenance Techniques up to 400 KV Lines using Bare Hand Method (BHM)" is scheduled to be conducted from 16.01.2017 to 17.02.2017. The course profile and other details are enclosed as Annexure I. The training programme offers direct benefit to the organizations involved in maintenance of transmission lines by reducing the number and duration of shutdowns. Learning the Bare Hand Techniques is essential in order to exploit the full potential of LLMT and it can increase the scope of Maintenance activities. In this programme, the trainees shall be trained to work adopting "BARE HAND METHOD" of LLMT on energized lines up to 400 KV. The nominated participants shall be physically fit, capable of working on the transmission towers as well as be conversant with the maintenance of power lines. Considering the risk involved, it is appreciated that all the nominees shall be provided with <u>adequate insurance cover</u> for the period of training by the sponsoring authority. The sponsoring organization is also advised to provide safety shoes and sun protective glasses to the trainees considering the nature of work involved during the training. The nominations along with full particulars of trainees duly filled in the enclosed Nomination Form (Annexure II) shall be sent to us well before the commencement date but latest by 05/01/2017.

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The trainees shall sign an Indemnity Bond on no-judicial stamp paper of (not less than) **Rs.50/-** at the time of joining the training course. A copy of the Blank Indemnity Bond is enclosed (Annexure – III) for your information and reference, which may please be duly completed in all respects and sent to this office before commencement of the course. No trainee who has not executed the Indemnity Bond will be allowed to participate in the training. The blank indemnity bond enclosed as **Annexure-III** may be made use of.

The training Programme is residential in nature and as far as possible the Hot Line Training Centre will make arrangements for the comfortable stay in the well-furnished Hostel inside HLTC Campus. Transport facility will be provided to the place of training and back to hostel.

As we normally accommodate around 25 trainees per course, nominations are accepted on first come first served basis. Hence it is absolutely essential that the nominations be sent so as to reach us at the earliest but NOT later than **05/01/2017**. The sponsoring authorities are advised to obtain written confirmation from this office before deputing the trainees to HLTC for the said training.

The course fee of ₹1,30,805/-(Rupees One Lakh Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred and Five Only) i.e.,(₹1,15,000/-+including Service tax of ₹15,805/-)includes training fee, boarding & lodging charges ,and service tax etc. & shall be payable by the sponsoring authorities to Hot Line Training Centre in advance. This payment is to be made by *Demand Draft preferably on State Bank Of India* drawn in favour of "DIRECTOR, HOT LINE TRAINING CENTRE, BANGALORE". In case the nominated participants attending the course are not bringing the demand draft with them, it can be sent by Speed Post or by Registered Post before hand along with nomination. The Course fee can also be sent by E-Transfer, for which the details of Bank are enclosed here with.

All other expenses in respect of the sponsored trainees, such as Pay, DA, TA, Special / Hot Line Allowance, etc. shall be borne by the sponsoring authority and such payments are to be made directly to the trainees and NOT through this office.

The trainees nominated for the course may be made aware of the contents of this circular especially Annexure IV & V.

## 5 WEEKS-TRAINING IN LIVE LINE MAINTENANCE TECHNIQUES UPTO 400 KV LINES USING BARE HAND TECHNIQUES (22<sup>nd</sup> Batch)

### **COURSE OUTLINE AND OTHER INFORMATION**

The fast developing Power System Network calls for least interruption in Power Supply and increased system security. Efficient operation and maintenance of existing and expanding Power System networks, which play a vital role in shaping the economy any country, necessitated adoption of specialized techniques for the maintenance of power transmission and distribution lines.

The Hot Line Training Centre was established at Bangalore to impart specialized training in Live Line Maintenance Techniques (LLMT) using Hot Stick Method (HSM) up to 220 KV to the personnel of the State Electricity Boards / Supply Undertakings all over India and Abroad. The fast growing power Transmission lines has made it imperative to upgrade the Live Line Maintenance Technology to train the personnel working on 400 KV lines as well. The course on Bare Hand Techniques up to 400 KV lines is well designed and planned to meet the needs of the power systems owned and operated by various power utilities in the country.

### 1. OBJECTIVE

The Training Programme has been organized with the following objectives:

- ❖ To Provide in-depth approach and technical know-how for live line maintenance
- To highlight the importance of maintenance of EHV Power Transmission lines using BARE HAND METHOD.

### 2. COURSE OUTLINE

- Brief revision on LLMT using HSM
- Introduction to maintenance of Power lines using Bare Hand Techniques
- Additional Safety aspects and requirements
- Practical oriented Operation covering various tower configurations
- ❖ Hands-on training on 400 kv commercial lines of various configurations
- Field training on testing of insulators
- Introduction to switchyard maintenance using LLMT.
- Study Tours to Certain Important substations and / transmission line locations, if time permits.

Major time will be devoted to impart training on 220kV/400 kV dummy transmission lines as well as on commercial lines of KPTCL/ POWERGRID dealing with practical aspects of maintenance.

### 3. **PERIOD:** 5 weeks, from 16.01.2017 to 17.02.2017

### 4. ELIGIBILITY

- a) The nominated trainees should have undergone LLMT training using HSM.
- b) The course is open to the Engineering Executives and Supervisory Staff as well as Linemen of Power utilities engaged in maintenance of EHV power lines.
- c) It is preferred that at least one of the nominees should be in the rank of Assistant Engineer/Junior Engineer, or Supervisor/Foreman and the other nominees may be in the level of Lineman/Asst. Lineman.
- d) The nominated trainees should be knowledgeable in English / Hindi or regional language and should have adequate transmission line field experience.
- e) Only the sponsored trainees shall be admitted to the course.
- f) The trainees should be in good health. We suggest that they should be subjected to Medical examination to ensure physical fitness.

### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRAINEES**

### I. ATTENDANCE:

As the training in Live Line Maintenance Techniques on 400 kV using Bare Hand Techniques is highly comprehensive and intensive, the attendance of the trainees for the complete course is compulsory and no leave of any kind will be sanctioned to the trainees during the course of training. It is advisable to sponsor only such candidates who will be punctual and regular in attendance. Absence by candidates will be viewed seriously and HLTC will not be in a position to issue Course Certificates in such cases.

### **II. INDEMINITY BOND:**

The trainees shall sign an Indemnity Bond on stamp paper at the time of joining the training course. No trainee will be allowed to take up training course without signing the bond.

### III. INSURANCE COVERAGE:

Trainees are advised to bring insurance cover at the time of joining the course.

### IV. ACCOMMODATION:

A well-furnished Hostel is available in the HLTC campus for the trainees. As the course is fully residential, the boarding and lodging are provided by HLTC. As far as possible the Hot Line Training Centre will make arrangements for the comfortable stay of the trainees.

### V. PHOTOGRAPHS:

Trainees have to bring One Stamp size and Two pass port size color photographs duly attested on the back of the photograph by the sponsoring organization at the time of reporting for training course.

### VI. SAFETY SHOES & SAFETY GLASSES:

As the nature of training demands regular climbing and working on the towers, the trainees need to be equipped with a pair of good quality **SAFETY SHOES** with thick rubber soles for providing electrical insulation, be sturdy, robust and secure for withstanding mechanical stresses. Non-availability of safety shoes will result in trainees not being able to take up hands-on training on towers. It is advised that the sponsoring authority shall ensure providing their trainees with Sun protective Glasses (for protecting eyes from ultra violet rays) before sending them for the training course.

### VII. HOW TO REACH:

The nominated candidates may be directed to alight at Bangalore City Railway Station/city Bus Stand. The institute is about 35 km from there. It is situated next to 220 kv Sub Station of Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Ltd (KPTCL) and 400 kv Sub-station of POWERGRID on Kanakapura Road (National Highway 209) and opposite to Acharya Patasala College (APS) of Engineering campus. Buses are available from Krishna Rajendra (K.R.) Market which is about 3 Km from City Railway station/City Bus stand. The Route Nos.
